

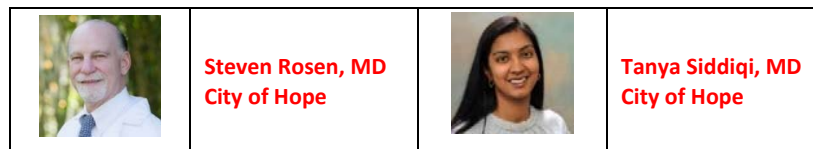


## CLL PATIENT AND CAREGIVER EDUCATIONAL FORUM
